Mr. Stringfellow made a motion seconded by Mr. Potter, that the minutes as read be approved but that the minutes also show that the new route for the canal was approved by the Board because it appeared that the right-of-way for the new route could be obtained at a much less sum than the estimated cost of the old route thereby effecting considerable savings and said motion was adopted.

On motion by Mr. Stringfellow, seconded by Mr. Weeks, vouchers number 263-271 was approved for payment.

On motion by Mr. Stringfellow, seconded by Mr. Weeks, the Board adjourned to meet again Wednesday, June 14, 1950 at 2:00 p.m. at the County Commissioners Office in Bradenton, Florida.
