On August 12, 1957, Chairman Ellsworth G. Simmons, of Hillsborough County, and Mr. Ed. F. McCann, of Sarasota County, Attorney Dewey A. Dye, Jr., Executive Secretary Fred W. Ball and Engineer, Joe K. Merrin, met in the Commissioners' Office in the Court House, Bradenton, Florida, but as only two members of the Commission were present, a quorum could not be formed and no meeting was held.

On August 13th, 1957, Commissioners Simmons, McCann, Pigott and Fischer agreed by telephone to approve the current bills for payment and instructed that checks be issued accordingly, and to approve the acquisition and payment of \$1,550.00 for R/W parcel owned by Fred B. and Thelma King of Charlotte Co. The next meeting of the West Coast Inland Navigation District will be held in Bradenton, Florida, on September 9th, 1957.
