

**WEST COAST INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT**

**FINAL PUBLIC HEARING**

**FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 1996**

**SARASOTA COUNTY SOUTH COUNTY ADMINISTRATION CENTER**

Chairman McClash called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. Commissioners Cummings, Judah, O'Neil were present. Executive Director, Charles W. Listowski, and counsel, Philip E. Perrey, were in attendance.

Chairman McClash announced the opening of the public hearing on WCIND's millage rate and budget for FY1996-97. He publicly stated that the proposed millage rate is .0189 and that .0189 mill is the rolled back rate so that taxes for FY1996-97 are not being increased. He opened the hearing for public comment. There was no one in the audience, and thus the public comment portion of the hearing was closed.

Commissioner Judah moved and Commissioner Cummings seconded to adopt the final millage rate of .0189. Motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Judah moved and Commissioner Cummings seconded to adopt the final budget for FY1996-97 with projected funds available of \$1,626,300 and total expenditures of \$1,626,300. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman McClash publicly announced that the name of the taxing authority named in the millage levy resolution is the West Coast Inland Navigation District, the rolled-back rate is .0189 mill, the proposed millage rate is .0189 mill, and the percentage increase of the final millage rate over the rolled-back rate is zero percent. Commissioner O'Neil moved and Commissioner Judah seconded to adopt the millage levy Resolution 96-3. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Cummings moved and Commissioner O'Neil seconded to adopt the budget Resolution 96-4 for FY1996-97. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner O'Neil apologized for missing the last Board Meeting. November 1, 1996 is the next meeting.

There being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the Final Budget Hearing at 5:08 p.m.
